As you are aware that the CCTNS is an important e-Governance project of the Government of India and its implementation must be concluded by March 2018. It has been observed from the Pragati Dashboard figures on the implementation of CCTNS project, received from States/UTs that many police stations are not filling up all the IIF forms. It is pertinent to mention that this incomplete information in the CCTNS database, will not provide comprehensive result when a search is made on crimes or criminals. Therefore, it is requested to ensure that all police stations should completely fill all 24 forms, including IIF1- IIF7, in the CCTNS software

2. Further, lack/ non-availability of network and power also impedes in the data being entered and transmitted to the State Data Centre (SDC). In this regard, it is requested to take follow up action so that such police stations keep filling up data in the offline mode and get the data transferred to the SDC from the nearest police station or the district headquarters.

3. During visits of NCRB teams to select police stations, it has also been observed that only a few members of staff in police stations are using the CCTNS software. Even the SHOs were not aware of the working and utility of the software, while other police personnel were either not interested or not motivated enough to use the computers. These stumbling

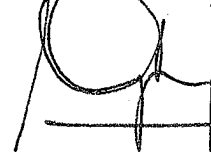
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blocks can only be removed when senior police officers take upon themselves to ensure that the state police owns the CCTNS project and uses the full functionality and power of the CCTNS for providing better services to the public.

4. In order to improve the situation, it is suggested that regular visits to police stations by the district SPs, Range IGs/ DIGs and Nodal Officers especially to review the implementation of CCTNS project in the Police Stations would be a great help in ensuring that the police station staff not only enter data completely & correctly, but also generate various kind of reports that bring their drudgery of manual reports down as well as help in crime investigation. Police Officers must be encouraged to use the software to search the database on various parameters on crime and criminals.

A format to record findings during such visit to police station by the superior officers is attached for your reference.
