

Sub.: Disciplinary action against members of Indian Police Service on violation of All India Services (Conduct) Rules, 1968 and withdrawal/forfeiture of Medals awarded.

I am directed to refer to the subject and to say that recently, some instances of behaviour unbecoming of IPS officers have been brought to the notice of this Ministry. It has been reported that the officers participated in a *dharna* organized by political leaders openly opposing the policy/actions of the Government. This is tantamount to extending support to a particular political party and a clear violation of the norms that should guide the conduct of IPS officers.

2. Such activities, especially by the officers of a uniformed service, are clearly in contravention of the provisions of the All India Services (Conduct) Rules, 1968. In this regard, the extant provisions of the Rules 3(1), 5(1) and 7 of the AIS (Conduct) Rules, 1968 clearly stipulate as under:

"3(1) Every member of the Service shall at all times maintain absolute integrity and devotion to duty and shall do nothing which is unbecoming of a member of the Service."

"5(1) No member of the Service shall be a member of, or be otherwise associated with, any political party or any organization which takes part in politics, nor shall he take part in, or subscribe in aid of, or assistant in any other manner, any political movement or political party."

"7. Criticism of Government.—No member of the Service shall, in any radio broadcast or communication over any public media or in any document published anonymously, pseudonymously or in his own name or in the name of any other person or in any communication to the press or in any public utterance, make any statement of fact or opinion,—


- i. Which has the effect of an adverse criticism of any current or recent policy or action of the Central Government or a State Government; or
- ii. which is capable of embarrassing the relations between the Central Government and any State Government; or
- iii. which is capable of embarrassing the relations between the Central Government and the Government of any Foreign State: Provided that nothing in this rule shall apply to any statement made or views expressed by a member of the Service in his official capacity and in the due performance of the duties assigned to him."

3. Such behaviour which is unbecoming of a member of the Service (IPS) renders him/her liable for disciplinary action. In addition, such behaviour by a member of the Service (IPS), which, in the opinion of President, brings the Force into disrepute, may result in withdrawal of Medals conferred on him/her by the Government, such as 'President's Police Medal', 'Police Medal', etc..

4. Attention is also invited that the Central Government undertakes empanelment process regularly to make a pool of eligible IPS officers who could hold the posts earmarked under Central deputation. Empanelment is a comprehensive assessment of an IPS officer for examining his/her suitability to occupy senior positions at the Centre, which is based on the overall profile, ACR/APARs, vigilance status, past records and multi-source feedback from the relevant stakeholders. Therefore, the officers indulging in such activities in contravention of the aforesaid Conduct Rules may not be empanelled for holding posts at the Centre.

5. All the State Governments/UTs are advised to bring the contents of this letter to the notice of all IPS officers serving under them for strict compliance of the aforesaid AIS (Conduct) Rules, 1968. It is further requested that in the cases of violation of Conduct Rules, departmental action under AIS (D&A) Rules, 1969 be initiated against the delinquent officer(s) and specific recommendations with regard to withdrawal/forfeiture of medals conferred on the officer(s) concerned, must be sent to this Ministry for taking further action.
