STANDING ORDER NO. 18.

- 1. Director, Central Monitoring Organisation of Ministry of Defence or his representative may visit a Police Radio Station with a view to suggesting improvements from security point of view.
- 2. The Police Radio Stations will be informed in advance about such visit. The Radio Station Officer will be personally present during his visit and assist him with the information required. Traffic and instructions on traffic security may be shown to him if required. No station records are to be given to him from the Station without my permission.
- 3. It is expected that the visiting officer will show his identifycation card to establish his identity and in case of doubt the matter may be referred to S.P.
- 4. Entries of such visits should be logged in the daily station log. In addition, the visiting officer may be asked to originate a radiogram to me regarding his visit.
- 5. R.S.Os will subtit a report to the undersigned immediately after the visit is over and also forward a copy of his observations recorded in visitors' book.
