STANDING ONDER NO. 23.

It has been observed that recoveries of advances remain pending against the officers of the Police Radio Branch for a considerable long time. This is being objected to by A. G. U. P.

- 2. Pue to the movement of men from place to place it becomes difficult to effect recoveries from them and very often recoveries are also evaded by the persons conserned with a view to misuse Govt. money.
- 3. It is therefore ordered that in future the Radio Station efficers will be a responsible for ensuring prompt recoveries of the dues from the Radio personnel working under them.
- 4. The Radio Station Officer will be intimated about the due against their Staff by A.R.C. (Admin) and they will see to it that the pending items are cleared as soon as possible. They will also intimate the dues out standing against a person transferred to the R.S.O. of the station of next posting with a copy to A.R.O. (Almin).
- 5. The Radio Station Officers should inform the personnel that un-lawful retention of Govt. money is a criminal offence under the I.P.C. and it is that also a misconduct on the part of a Govt. servant.
- 6. The R. M.Os and R. Is will be responsible to ensure the compliance of this order by checking up the action taken during their visit Radio Stations.
- 7. Appropriate misconduct entries will, in fiture, be awarded to defaulters who do not promptly pay back the Govt. money, due on them and R. I., R. M. O. and R. S. O. will also be held responsible for the lack of initiation shown by them in getting the matters settled seen.
